

## PETITION CIRCULATOR INFORMATION

All petition circulators must be qualified to register to vote in the state of Arizona.

Petition signers must be registered to vote in the City of Scottsdale. Since City Council is a nonpartisan race, voters of any party affiliation may sign the petition.

All signatures on a petition must be signed as the person is registered to vote. Their middle initial or middle name must be included in their signature if that is how the signer is registered to vote (it usually is).

While any color ink or type of pen is legal, signatures made with a black ballpoint pen are the most legible.

If a person signs incorrectly you may cross out that line and have them re-sign on the next line. This will not void the petition.

Petition signers may sign a total of 3 petitions.

Please fill out the necessary information on the back of the petition and sign it before you return the petition to me.

Please return your petitions to me as soon as possible, absolutely no later than **March 1, 2010**. The mailing address is:
